



COURSE INQUIRY

A course inquiry is both a starting point for a writing course and a way to center the diverse work that gets produced throughout the semester. In this sample, the course inquiry is unpacked as four major assignments.

Assigned readings could include narratives, critical and scholarly pieces, journalism, social media and popular cultural materials as well as audio and video texts, such as the podcast *Nice White Parents* or the film *Homework*.

Studio sessions would build toward proficiency in gathering and circulating interview/profile materials and could engage related aspects of: ethical engagement with sources, capturing and editing audio and video, captioning and accessibility, rhetorical analysis of various educational sites, and more.
